

Dear VRCS Families,

The St. Stephen Campus will move to remote instruction from December 9 to December 17. In-person instruction will resume on Monday, December 20, 2021.

As the PA Department of Health recommends, the St. Stephen Campus will move to remote instruction due to fifteen active COVID-19 cases and thirteen additional students required to quarantine.

The Venango Catholic Jr./Sr. High School will remain open for in-person instruction.

During the next ten days, I ask you to please monitor your child for any symptoms of COVID-19. As stated by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), people with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. This list does not include all possible symptoms.

- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell

- Diarrhea
