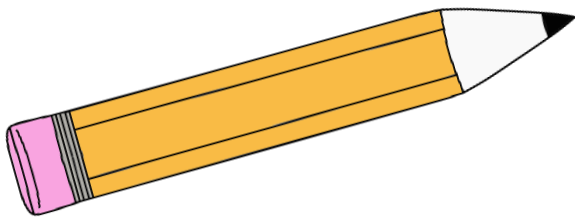

KINDERGARTEN

- 2 rolls paper towels

Backpacks

Backpacks are required for students to carry materials to and from school. Please do not send additional toys, games or non-school items in backpacks. Students and parents should develop a routine to nightly review assignments planners and empty backpacks.

Snacks/Lunch

All students are permitted to bring ONE snack for mid-morning. This snack should be nutritious in nature and DRY (no yogurt, fruitcups, etc.). Many classes continue with instruction while enjoying their snack, so the simpler and less messy the better. If students purchase lunch, they still need to bring a snack—we are not able to provide snacks to students who forget to pack them.

Students packing lunch should bring everything they will need to eat—this includes all cutlery and napkins. This year, students will not be permitted to heat any food in microwaves. Lunch should be nutritious, well-balanced and of appropriate portions. Please ensure that students are able to open all of their lunch items independently. Milk is available for purchase at lunch for all students (please use FACTS portal to purchase).

Water Bottles

Students may bring in a reusable water bottle to school to use throughout the day. Please send full bottles in the morning. Bottle filler stations will be available on the bottom and middle floors for re-fills. If a student forgets to bring a bottle, we do not have extras to distribute. They will be permitted to use the water fountain as needed throughout the day. Only plain water is permitted in water bottles. Please do not send sports drinks, flavored water, or juice.

Uniforms

Please adhere to the uniform policy. If your child comes to school out of uniform, we cannot guarantee that we have spare items to bring them up to code. If they are out of dress code, we will either call a parent to bring the correct clothing or issue a demerit (see handbook). School dress shoes (not sneakers) are to be worn every day while in uniform (except for recess/gym). Socks should also adhere to uniform policy.

Remember—for Mass Day!

- Boys must have a tie that is solid red, solid black or school plaid (only available at Shaheens).
- Both boys and girls should have a clean, pressed white button-up shirt to wear for mass day. Please replace/iron and as needed.
