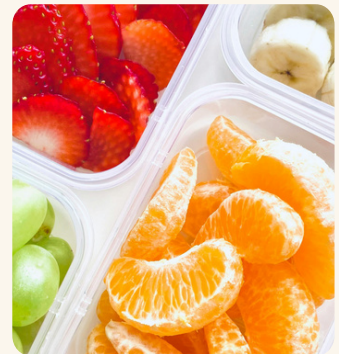


Backpacks

Backpacks are required for students to carry materials to and from school. Please do not send additional toys, games or non-school items in backpacks. Students and parents should develop a routine to nightly review assignment planners (grades 3-8) and empty backpacks.

Snacks

All students are permitted to bring ONE snack for mid-morning. This snack should be nutritious in nature and DRY (no yogurt, fruitcups, etc.). Many classes continue with instruction while enjoying their snack, so the simpler and less messy the better.



Lunch



Students should bring everything they will need to eat their lunch—this includes all cutlery and napkins. Please ensure that students are able to open all of their lunch items independently. Students do not have access to microwaves to heat any food. Lunch should be nutritious, well-balanced and of appropriate portions. We kindly ask that parents adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Students are not permitted to have soda/energy drinks.**
- **Fast food is not permitted—please do not drop off fast food, or have students return to school with fast food after appointments.**



Treats in the Classroom (Parties/Celebrations)

We strongly recommend that all classroom treats and snacks be commercially prepared and store-bought with ingredient labels. This helps reduce the risk of contamination and protects students with food allergies or other dietary needs. Before sending in treats, please communicate with your child's classroom teacher regarding any allergies, dietary restrictions, or other student needs within the classroom.

Water Bottles

Students may bring in a reusable water bottle to school to use throughout the day.

Only plain water is permitted in water bottles.

Please do not send sports drinks, flavored water, or juice. Please send full bottles in the morning. Bottle filler stations will be available on the bottom and middle floors for re-fills. If a student forgets to bring a bottle, we do not have extras to distribute. They will be permitted to use the water fountain as needed throughout the day.

Uniforms

Please adhere to the uniform policy. If your child comes to school out of uniform, we cannot guarantee that we have spare items to bring them up to code. If they are out of dress code, we will either call a parent to bring the correct clothing or issue a demerit (see handbook). School dress shoes (not sneakers) are to be worn every day while in uniform (except for recess/gym). Socks should also adhere to uniform policy.

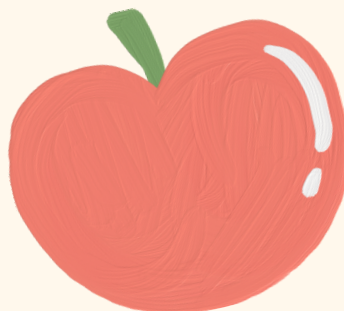
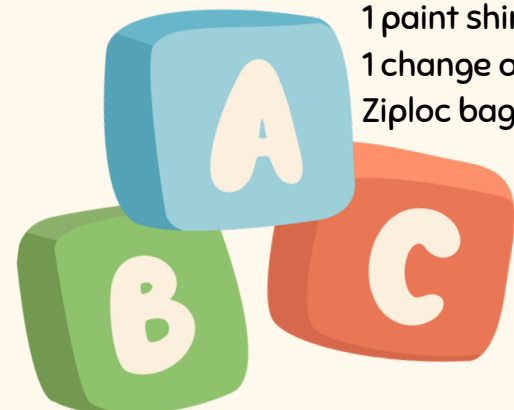

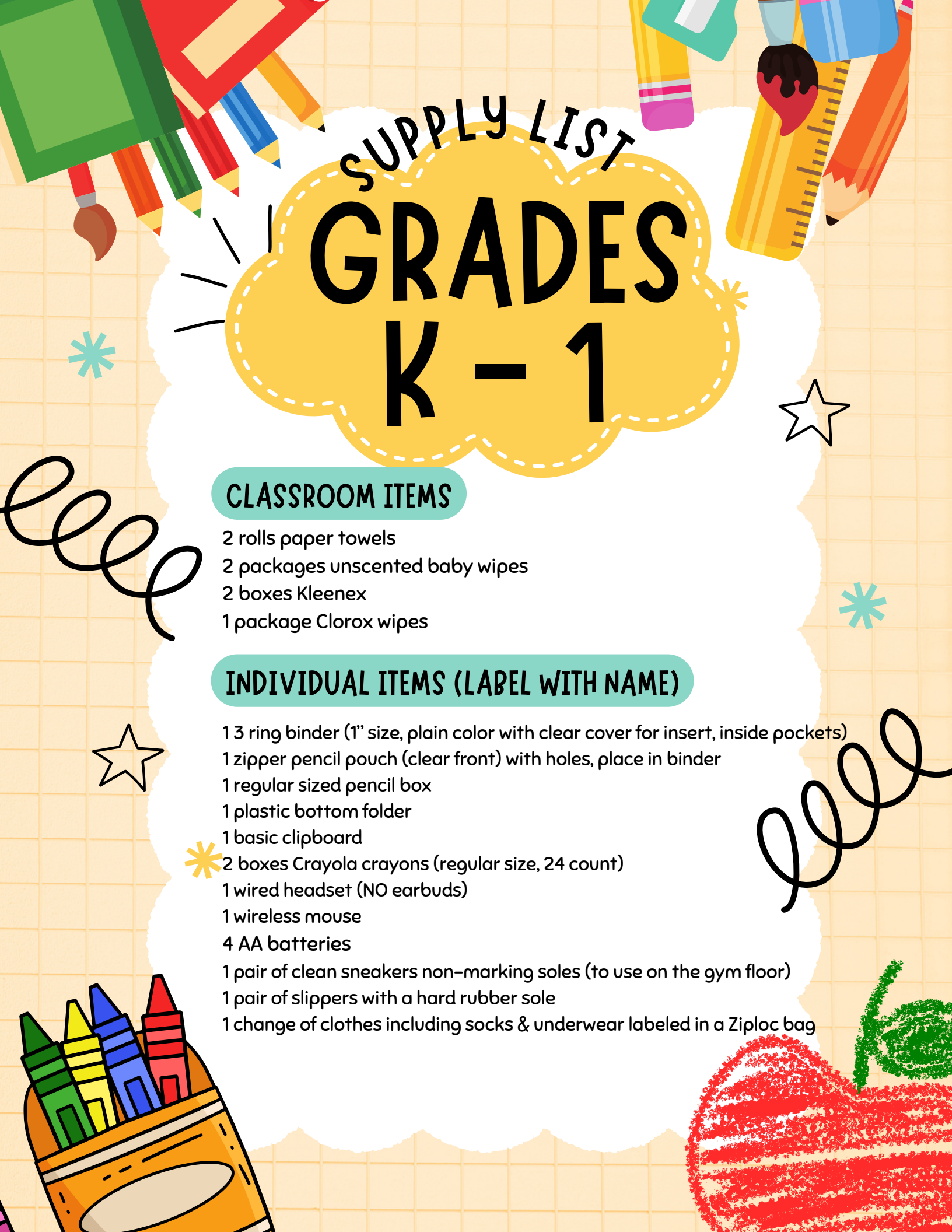
CLASSROOM ITEMS
